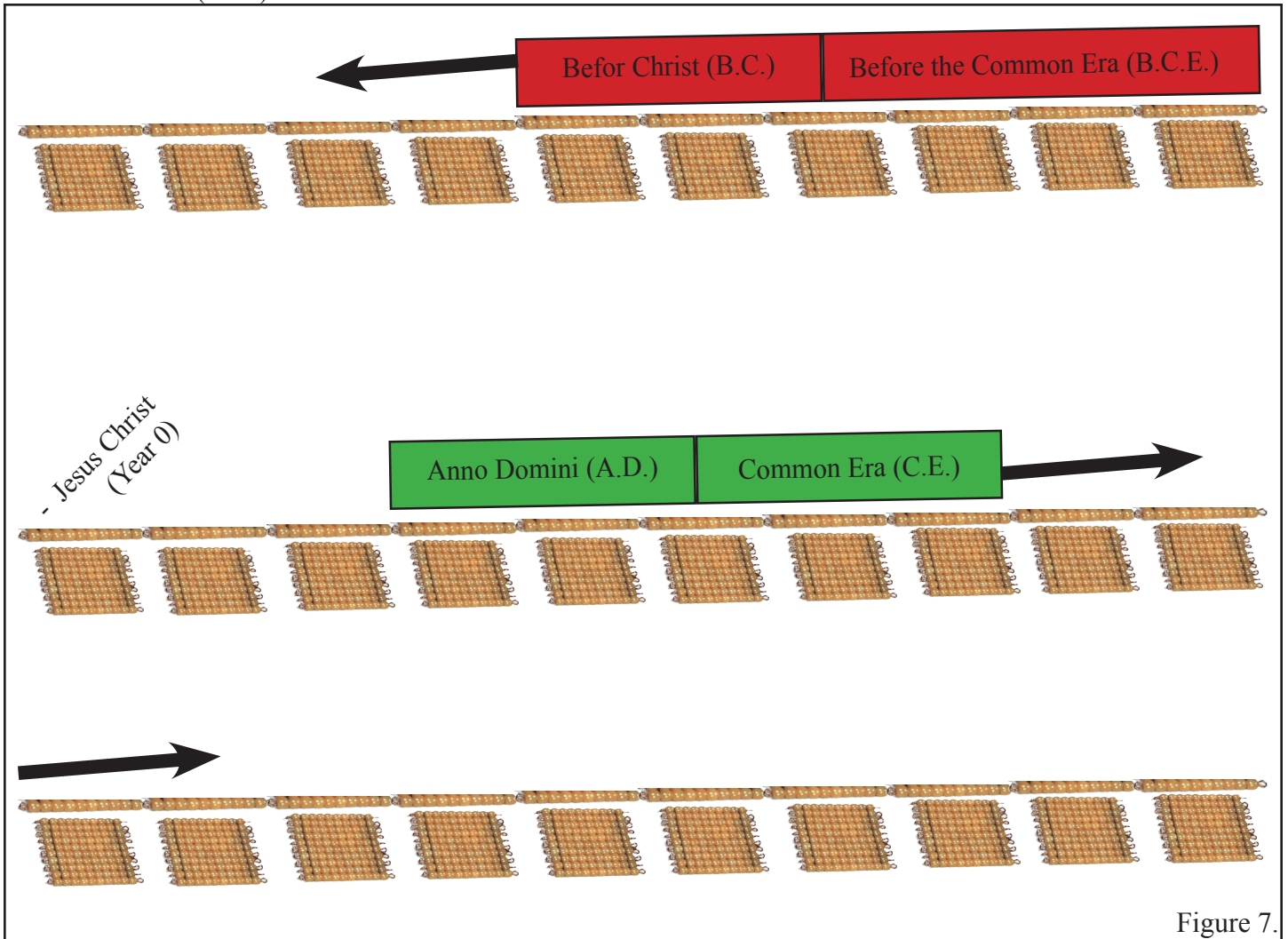

- History of earth: from the beginning to the present time.

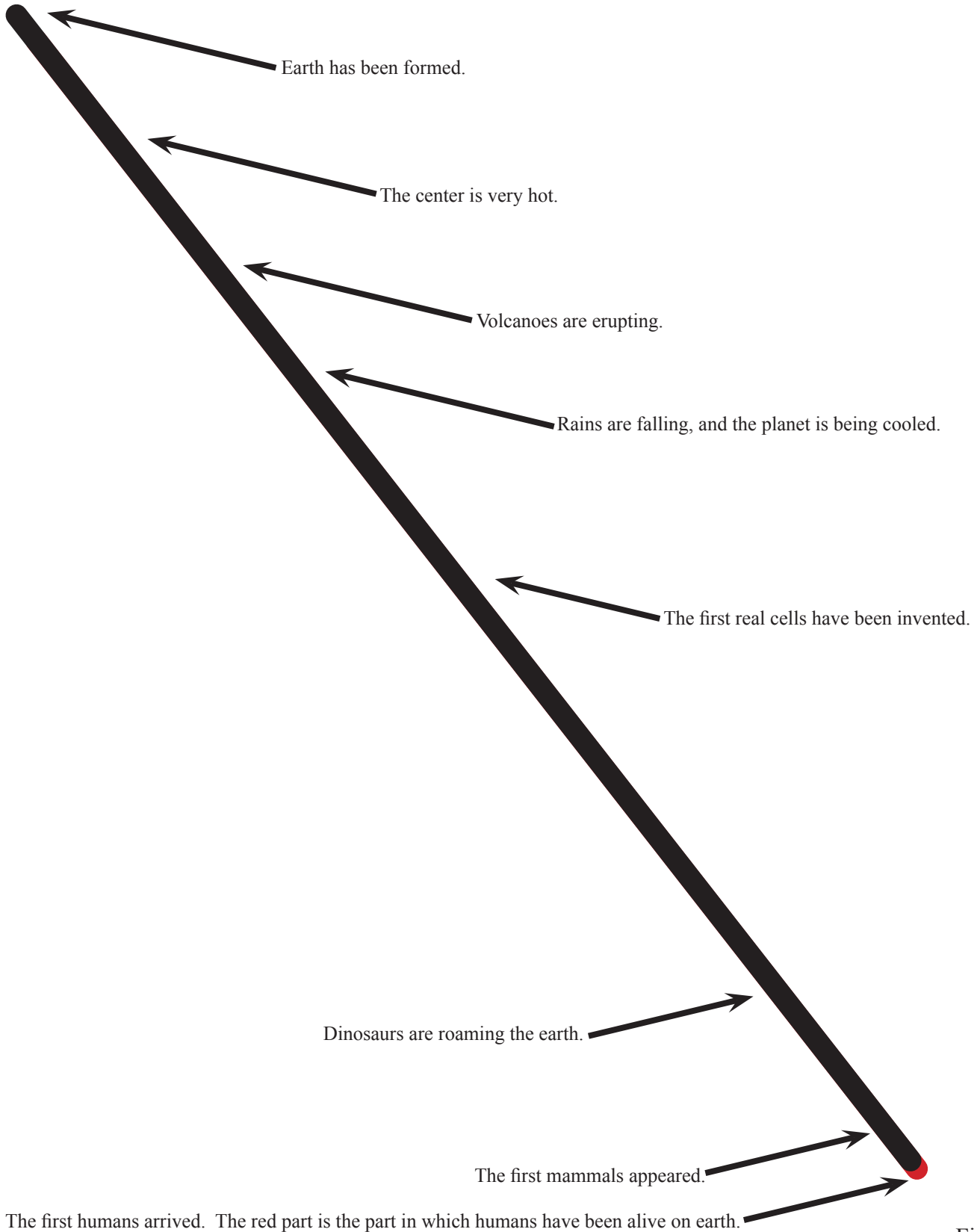
